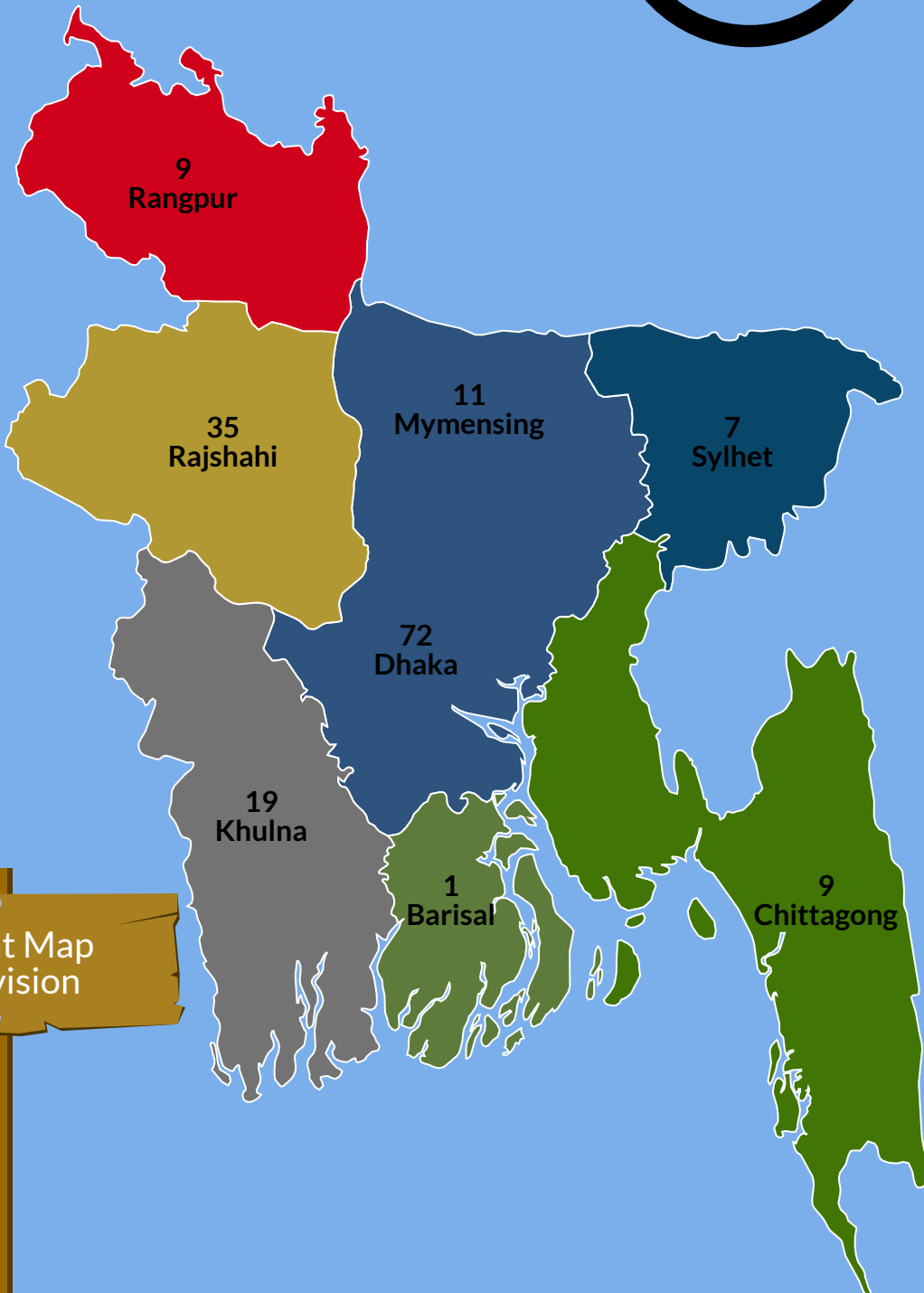

## Year 2017 at a glance

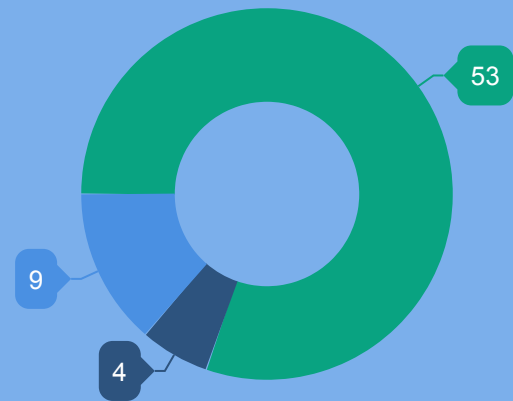
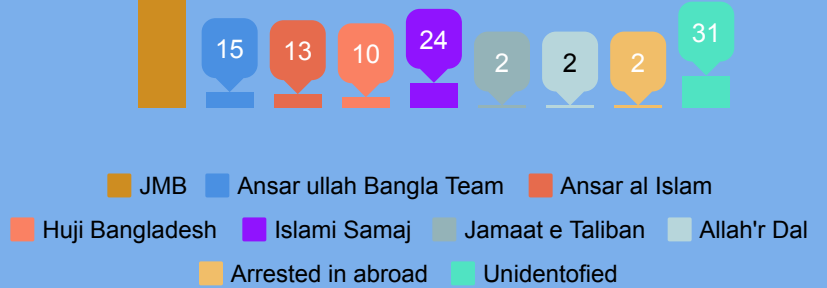


Incident Map

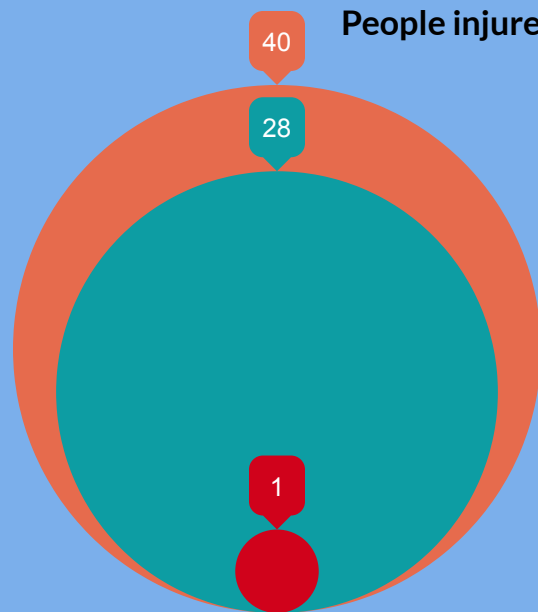
People arrested by different category

# Legal Actions 2017

**Government banned Ansar Al Islam, the Bangladesh chapter of AQIS, as its activities already posed a threat to public security.**

---

**Government directed Bangladesh Madrasa Education Board to remove the chapters on Jihad to curb controversy regarding the madrasa education system.**

## Prosecution/Execution:

- 13 February 2017 - A court in Dinajpur District indicted five militants (Saddam Hossan, Osman Goni, Ahsan Habib, Jobayer Hossain and Ramzan Ali) of JMB for looting a refuelling station in 2015.
- 14 February 2017 - A Dhaka court indicted former JMB ameer Saidur Rahman, Abdullah Kafi and his wife Ayesha Akhter.
- 28 February - A Rangpur Court awarded death penalties to Rangpur 'region military commander' of JMB Masud Rana Mamun, Ishaque Ali, Liton Mia Rafiq, Shakhawat Hossain and Ahsanullah Ansari Biplob for killing Japanese national Kunio Hoshi in 2015.
- 6 March 2017 - Chapainawabganj Court sentenced a militant of JMB to life term imprisonment in an arms case filed on 7 July 2009.
- 15 March 2016 - A Dhaka court framed charges against 11 militants of JMB in a case filed over carrying out attacks on VIPs, VVIPs and at important establishments in the country.
- 19 March 2017 - SC upheld death penalty on HuJI-B leader Mufti Hannan, Shahedul Alam alias Bipul and Delwar Hossain alias Ripon for attempting to kill British envoy to Bangladesh in 2004.
- 12 April 2017 - HuJI-B's Chief Mufti Abdul Hannan and associate Sharif Shahedul Alam alias Bipul and Delwar alias Ripon were hanged for grenade attack on former British envoy Anwar Choudhury in Sylhet District in 2004.
- 25 May 2017 - Former JMB 'chief' Maulana Saidur Rahman, Abdullah Hel Kafi and his wife Ayesha Akhter were sentenced to seven and half years of imprisonment in a case filed for planning subversive activities in May 2010.
- 4 June 2017 - A Chittagong Court indicted five militants of HuJI-B (Tazul Islam, NazimUddin, Abu Jar Gifari, Nure Alam and Iftisham Ahmed).
- 24 July 2017 - Dhaka High Court sentenced three JMB militants to different terms of imprisonment in a case filed for bombs blasts in Farmgate, Dhaka city during a series bomb blasts across the country on August 17, 2005.
- 31 July 2017 - Chapainawabganj District Court sentenced a militant of JMB (Mohamad Selim alias Harun Mistri - 34) to life term imprisonment in an arms case.
- 8 August 2017 - Tangail District Court sentenced 14 cadres of JMB to 20 years' rigorous imprisonment in a case of August 17, 2005 serial blasts in Tangail District.
- 16 August 2017 - A special court in Rangpur District indicted 12 militants of JMB for killing Khadem Rahmat Ali on November 10, 2015.
- 26 September 2017 - A court in Chittagong District jailed three militants of JMB for 14 years in two cases filed in connection with hurling bombs at judges in two courtrooms in 2005.
- 29 November 2017 - A court in Dinajpur District indicted eight militants of Neo-JMB for attacking Italian national Dr Piero Parolari on November 18 in 2015.
